"I'd also like to try all those lovely pastries people tell me about.

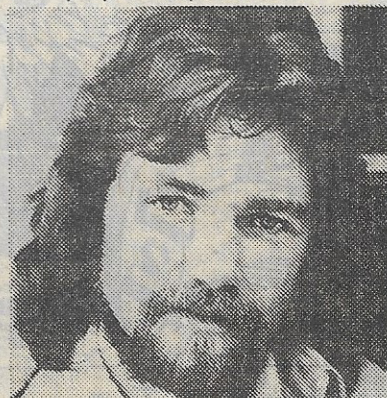
