Add a beautiful, sexy, intelligent blonde, who can knock you down with her elegance and charm, or knock you through a plate-glass window with a thrust of her hip.

Mix them together and you have The New Avengers, three super-cool agents

dedicated to fighting for Her Majesty's Secret Service.

The New Avengers stars Patrick Macnee as Steed, Gareth Hunt as Gambit, and Joanna Lumley as the beautiful Purdey.

Patrick Macnee has played the role of the dapper John Steed since the show's inception in 1961.

Gareth Hunt as Gambit is a newly-created role. In the original Avengers series, Steed was assisted solely by a female companion.

Joanna Lumley is the latest in the lush female line.

Author of The Avengers, Brian Clemens, has written for all the Avengers' girls.

"I think we were always ahead of our time with the liberated ladies, such as Cathy Gale and Emma Peel," he says.

"The next extension to Women's Lib, I thought, was the woman like Purdey, so sure of herself that she can put her bra back on again.

"To find Purdey, I investigated about 700 girls. I actually interviewed 200, read scripts with 40, and screentested 15.

'I knew Joanna was the right one. She is good to look at, and is witty, charming, feminine and elegant.''

Last year, after The Avengers had been on the shelf for seven years, Clemens formed The Avengers (Film and TV) Enterprises Ltd.

It was backed by more than \$5-million of French money after the British film industry declined to support it.

The New Avengers is setting new precedents. Three episodes of the series were filmed in the chateau country around Paris, and four in Canada. #
