IN THE last 10 months, Joanna Lumley, arguably the best-looking actress on TV today, has led a pretty dangerous existence.

She has indulged in some vicious karate fights, leaped cat-like over a 10ft. high jagged fence, and climbed a rope-ladder which was loosely suspended from a helicopter. She has also scaled a few walls where one false move, she assured me, might have resulted in her falling to her death. But most taxing of all was the series of army manoeuvres she has undergone: manoeuvres so physically demanding that few men of her acquaintance would have managed to stay the

why does she do it? To bring a touch of authenticity to the tough-girl role of Purdey in TV's New Avengers series.

And, of course, the sort of money Miss Lumley is earning for the first time in her life makes the rough-and-tumble of it all more than worth while; though money, she says is not all that important to her.

"As a struggling actress I've known what it's like to be poor, but, at the same time, I must admit I've never known poverty. My parents have always been quite comfortably off, and while it was never my intention to scrounge off them, I knew they would never let me starve.



"What any fairly good-looking girl would do. I set my sights on a fellow, flashed him a radiant smile, like this," she said, and demonstrated, "and when he invited me out to dinner, I accepted. And once I was satisfied that he could afford it, I'd eat as much as I could to keep me going for at least three days. And when he wasn't looking I'd slip a few rolls or whatever else remained on the table, into my bag.

"Lots of struggling young actresses do that sort of thing, you know. It was all part of the romantic image we have of ourselves as would-be stars."



Yet she started of! not as an actress but as a model.

"Actually," she said, "I started off as Walter Mitty. From the age of about seven I was an incredible day-dreamer. I'd create elaborate fantasies for myself in which I was Carruthers, an ace pilot who managed to land a blazing plane on half an engine and one wheel, having successfully and single-handedly bombed the whole of Germany.

"You know the sort of thing. I became that pilot, and, in acting out my fantasies, I was having my first taste of what it was like to 'perform.'

"But of course, you're right," she said. "The first professional work I did was as a model. I don't know why. I suppose because I'm. basically lazy and I thought that modelling would be easier, which, in a sense, it is.

"If you've got the right physical equipment, you're three-quarters of the way there. On the other hand, it can be quite difficult too. there. On the other hand, it can be quite difficult too. When I first became a model, round about 1965, the word 'model' had some rather unfortunate connotations. The Christine Keeler case was in full swing, and she and Mandy Rice-Davies also called themselves models.

shock! But once he saw it was a perfectly respectable profession for a young girl, he accepted it. Just as he's accepted everything else I've done in life. Both my parents are pretty good that way.

"Anyway, for a while it all went very well, particularly the travelling around, which I loved. But the thing about modelling. I found, was that you soon become very obsessed with yourself. You have to. Everything depends on the way you look, and after a while you find yourself looking.

"Also, I learned, once you've been a model, you have one helluva time trying to convince producers and directors you can also act. They just refuse to take you seriously. Fortunately," she said, "I persevered and have been lucky."

Extremely lucky.

"Well, yes. In fact, I still can't believe what's happened in only ten months. For the first time I'm getting hundreds of fan letters a week and people are actually treating

very impressed," she said.

"And Joanna Lumley the real me—who is a completely separate person is very pleased for her. Now, if this sounds like I have a split personality, well, in a sense I have. I keep my private life completely separate from my professional one.

So much so," she said,
"that when I see my name in print or hear it on TV or the radio, I actually get embarrassed."

She paused "A lot of people are terribly disappointed when they meet me, you know. They expect me just to be like Purdey. And when I tell them that there's nothing bionic," about me, that I'm the most gentle, docile creature in the world, and never drive faster than the law allows and faint at the sight of blood, they won't accept it.

"I've even done some TV interviews in Holland where they've cut all that out when I don't live up to it, you can see the disbellef on their faces.

Anyway, my only real extravagance is shoes. Apart from that I'm pretty careful with cash.

"My main concern will be to see that my son James (who is nine) has a good education. Before the series came along I wasn't so sure this would be possible." for the past two years, Joanna has lived with Michael Kitchen, one of the National Theatre's most impressive and accomplished young actors. Her past boy friends have included Patrick Lichfield and Rod Stewart. When she was 21, she married actor Jeremy Lloyd. The marriage lasted Lloyd. The marriage lasted eight months!

Lloyd is not the father of her son and to date she has refused to say who is.

Which we are." Will she marry Kitchen?




